



To make a model of the Weekender, print these templates to the size you want your model (you may want to size them with a copy machine.) Use them to cut out parts on cardstock, basswood sheets or whatever and assemble. The keel should be made from 2-3 layers or thicker material. You will need to make 2 parts from some templates. The ruler will also be to scale. You may need to use the line drawings to know proper placement. Some small parts are not included.

Use dowels for the spars (lengths are: Mast: 15', Bowsprit: 5', Clubfoot: 5', Boom: 11', Gaff: 6' 2")
 Sails are: Jib: 148" x 76" x 118", Main: luff: 118", foot: 127", leech: 170", top: 86" with 142 deg. throat.
